





## **General Notes:**

- Poured concrete or block foundation. Could be ICF and sealed crawlspace for storage and thermal mass.
- 2x6, R-21+ wall framing. R-38+ cathedral roof framing.
- Main floor framing: wood joists or I-joists.
- Upper floor framing: Exposed beam and 2x6 decking. Alt, wood joists and drywall ceiling.
- Heating options: Wood stove with electric wall heat- Could also be superinsulated using the "poor mans ers, gas furnace & AC ducted through floors (no
- decking), In-floor radiant in 1.5" slab on main w/ baseboard radiators @ upper.
- Upper floor loft can be closed off for 4th bedroom.
- Sunroom, upper bedrooms and Great Room can have more skylights for additional overhead light.
- House could be panelized or produced using SIP panels for quicker assembly on site.
